- endorsement by Tribe of which applicant is a member or employee (A sample endorsement letter is included in Candidate Application Kit.)

OR

- referral by the CIMC Workforce Development Program as a program participant (Visit www.cimcinc.org for information on the CIMC Workforce Development Program.)

AND

- A resident of CIMC's service area (Visit www.cimcinc.org for information on CIMC's service area.)
- American Indian heritage (verifiable)
- 18 years of age or older

**This application process is competitive and applications must be complete to be considered.
Class size is limited.**

Applicants selected to receive training must agree to participate in CIMC's Workforce Development Program intake/eligibility process and attend all four sessions.
