

RESOLUTION FORMAT

California Indian Manpower Consortium Grant Agreement for Program Years beginning July 1, 2011 and ending on June 30, 2012

- WHEREAS:** the Indian people suffer from employment barriers which are even more severe than those of most non-Indians; and
- WHEREAS:** the Congress of the United States has acted to alleviate this situation by making funds available under Indian and Native American provisions of the Workforce Investment Act; and
- WHEREAS:** Congress has made, from time to time, funds available under other provisions of the Workforce Investment Act; and
- WHEREAS:** we recognize the most efficient disbursement of these funds can be accomplished through the establishment of a consortium, and
- WHEREAS:** the California Indian Manpower Consortium proposes to operate such a consortium, and
- WHEREAS:** we are eligible under the guidelines for Indian Employment and Training Programs to join a consortium.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that this resolution be attached to and become part of the California Indian Manpower Consortium grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we exercise the necessary authority, including all necessary legal authority, to enter into the California Indian Manpower Consortium Agreement and join the California Indian Manpower Consortium, Inc.
